## FIRST PACIFIC WINS FOUR INTERNATIONAL AWARDS FOR 1997 ANNUAL REPORT

First Pacific Company Limited announced today that its 1997 Annual Report has received four prizes, including three gold medals, at the 12th annual International ARC Awards competition in New York, which is known as the Academy Awards of Annual Reports.
