As has previously been stated, in the context of media speculation in late 1998 in relation to the possible sale of the Bank, First Pacific is continually engaged in reviewing strategic alternatives as regards each of its investments and its overall investment portfolio, including the Bank.

However, the boards of the two companies confirm that there are no negotiations or agreements relating to an intended sale of the Bank that are discloseable under paragraph 3 of the Listing Agreement and the boards also are unaware of any other matter discloseable under the general obligation imposed by paragraph 2 of the Listing Agreement, which is or may be of a price-sensitive nature.
